ODLO wins ISPO Award for innovative ski touring apparel

The independent jury of the ISPO Award recently chose to honour the X-Alp Performance ski touring apparel from ODLO with the prestigious industry award. The distinguished ensemble comprising X-Alp Performance Knit 3L jacket and X-Alp Performance Knit 3L pants was created based on PFC-free warp-knitted laminates from Trans-Textil. The intentionally designed open 3D structures are a direct outcome of the knitting process and offer a glimpse of the individually coloured Topaz membrane system. This watertight and breathable barrier thus ensures reliable protection and comfort, while also serving as a design element.

For the sixth year in a row, a design innovation from ODLO has been honoured with the ISPO Award at the world's largest sports trade show. As part of a new generation of high-performance ski touring apparel launching in September 2023, the X-Alp Performance Knit 3L jacket and pants combine the comfort and range of motion of softshells with the three-layer protection of hardshells for a wide variety of winter sports.

The 3D warp-knitted laminates from Trans-Textil present an ideal basis for satisfying these high demands. As multilayer composites, they gain their 4-way stretch factor through the special Point-in-Point® lamination technology, providing maximum freedom of movement. The targeted design of functional zones based on the Dreamshape®-Technology from Penn Textile Solutions makes it possible to cater to the specific

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requirements of different body regions. For example, mesh zones with a defined hole size for made-tomeasure breathability or abrasion-resistant 3D structures can be placed exactly where they are required. This means the clothing is durable and extremely climate-friendly.

Thanks to the flexible membrane production by Trans-Textil, any colour variants can be produced according to customer requirements within a very short space of time and without any restrictions in performance. In combination with other environmentally friendly technology modules such as the PFC-free, water-repellent surface finish Topaz Clean4Green®, Trans-Textil realizes functional textile products for insulation jackets, both hardshells and softshells, which meet the highest demands on performance, design and environmental performance. All materials, including the Topaz membrane systems, are free of PFC, certified according to Standard 100 by Oeko-Tex® and processed in Germany under the strictest environmental requirements in accordance with REACH. The complete production chain "Made in Germany" offers high flexibility and short distances, which keeps CO2 pollution from transport routes to a minimum.
